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## SECTION I

### INTRODUCTION

#### **What is this paper about?**

This monograph will contribute to a topic that is not very common in some English books but whose importance is relevant in the study of the English Language: An English Learners Guide of Derivative Words in English from Regular and usually Transitive Verbs.

When studying a language, students are interested in seeing how it works, and in order to do this, they break it into small items to see their function and then, they put them together again. Having this knowledge, we can use the language in a correct way, not only in writing but also in speaking.

The aim of the present monograph is to provide a guide of some of the derivative words that exist in English. These derivative words are formed by adding affixes to a root word. In this specific case, this guide is based on derivative words whose root words are verbs; and they are only regular and usually transitive verbs of frequent use.

One of the reasons regular verbs were chosen was because the majority of lexical verbs in English are regular, that is, they take the regular -ed suffix for both the past form and the -ing participle form.<sup>1</sup>

This guide will provide a list of derivative words coming from regular and transitive verbs in English. This list consists of the verb and the words derived from them by adding some affixes, these can be prefixes at the beginning of the word, or suffixes at the end of the word, their grammatical function, as well as their translation into the Spanish language.

### **What is the purpose of this paper?**

When you read something in English, there may be some vocabulary that you don't understand, and as it takes time to look up these words in a dictionary, it will help to learn some strategies for guessing the meanings. One way to do this is by looking at the morphology of the word.

It can be used as a supplementary tool for students of English to explain the use and general meaning of the prefixes and suffixes used. It can also be used as a guide to some word formation patterns.

Vocabulary is a very important part of learning a new language. This guide will help students with the idea that by looking at the morphology of words with which they are not familiar, they can determine their function and meaning pretty accurately.

As UQROO is growing in number of students, I think that it needs to enlarge and improve the quality of service of the library to help and facilitate students with material. I feel this guide will be very useful for this purpose, because it would be useful for all people interested in learning.

### **Who benefits from this paper?**

It can be used by students who are going to take the FCE exam, because there is a section in which a word is given and you have to complete a sentence filling the blanks with a word derived from the word given.

English teachers can consult the patterns of how words are formed, the different affixes that can be added to words, and see the most common regular and transitive verbs because this work includes a brief explanation, the meaning, and the form of these verbs.

But this guide is not only made for teachers and students, but also for all people interested in learning the English language by themselves as a means of learning vocabulary by groups and not by isolated items. Universities, such as UQROO are training future English teachers, tourist guides and professionals who require English as a second language and it is necessary to have a wide variety of sources in English for students.

### **How is this paper organized?**

This monograph is organized in sections. The first section contains the introduction, the investigation obtained from the books read; this is the theoretical basis, the theory, definitions, explanations and some examples. The second section is the list of words, which is organized in four columns.

The first column has the verbs in English. The second column has the words derived from the verb. In the third column the grammatical functions of the

derivative words are written. In the fourth column there are the translations into Spanish of the derivative words. The third section is composed of the conclusions, recommendations, notes, and bibliography.

The idea of doing this paper resulted from my necessity of studying for my FCE exam, and also because there is a lack of material for research in the area of English, particularly in books related to Morphology. The material includes books, guides, theses or other monographies, not only at the UQROO but also in other Universities in the state of Quintana Roo. First of all, I wanted to do a guide of derivative words considering that in the future this guide will be read by many people preparing to take a proficiency exam.

The first thing I did was to decide what kind of guide to do because I had the option of doing it about nouns, adjectives or verbs. I decided to do it about verbs because I consider they are an important and essential part of a sentence. We need to understand various features of verbs in order to construct a correct sentence.

Reading in grammar, linguistics and morphology books was done. From them, I got the grammatical and the morphological information I needed but I didn't get a complete list of prefixes or suffixes. They only gave brief examples.

To get information about derivational morphemes (prefixes and suffixes), I turned to Internet sites mainly in many pages specialized on this topic to get the most common prefixes and suffixes.

I not only entered in Web sites where I got lists of regular and transitive verbs but I also got lists of these verbs in grammar books. All this was in order to select the verbs I was going to focus on.

Having compiled all that information, I selected the verbs. There were thousands of verbs, but I chose the ones that we use frequently, because, as in the Spanish language, there are verbs in the dictionary that even a native speaker seldom uses. There were verbs that I didn't add to this guide. Such verbs were the ones that didn't have a derivative word or the ones whose base or root word was a noun or an adjective. This is known as conversion.<sup>ii</sup> But in this work we are not dealing with this process but I considered it very important to make this distinction between conversion and derivation.

After having chosen all the verbs, I proceeded to write all their derivatives and their respective grammatical functions. That is all those words that have the same root word, the verb, and the prefixes and suffixes I had already found in internet sites and in books. Some definitions of words don't have anything to do with the meaning of the family of the root word; such words were not added to this work.

The inclusion of the function was done because I think it is important to see the different grammatical categories a word can belong to only by the fact of attaching affixes.

The part of my research I considered the most difficult was when I had to investigate the root of the word. Some words were easy to recognize because they didn't have any noun, for instance the verb *admit*. But there were words that have the function of verbs and nouns such is the case of *circle*.

When this case appeared, I chose the option of writing the derivative words that belonged only to verbs. There were affixes that were added mainly to verbs to turn these into adjectives, nouns, adverbs or into other verbs.

There were some cases of verbs that when already attached an affix they became adjectives or nouns. Such is the case of the verb *agree*. First, the prefix *able* was attached to the verb to become *agreeable* which is an adjective, and then, the suffix *ness*, was attached to the adjective to finally have the noun *agreeableness*.

The equivalent into the Spanish language was done because one of the aims of this work, as it was expressed before, is to help students, mainly beginners to learn vocabulary. Some derivative words have two or more meanings in the Spanish language, but I only selected the meaning that is related with the root word.

## THEORETICAL BASIS

### AFFIX

It is a morpheme which only occurs when attached to a root. Affixes can change the meaning or functions of the words they are attached to. Affixes are divided in *prefixes* and *suffixes*.

**Prefix.** A prefix is one or more syllables that can be added at the beginning of a word or root to change its meaning.<sup>111</sup> For example *restate*. We can also have multiple prefixes; this is, adding more than one prefix to a word as in *polyunsaturated*.

**Suffix.** A suffix is a part word added to the end of a word to change its meaning. *Quietness* is a good example of this kind of derivational morpheme. Multiple suffixation is possible as in *hope/lessness*, where two suffixes are added.

**Class Changing Affixes.** These changes occur because affixes, whether a prefix, a suffix, or both are added at the beginning or at the end of the word. There are some changes by adding prefixes to a verb; we can change a verb into a noun, adjective, and into another verb. By adding suffixes we can find that a verb can form a noun, adjective, another verb, adverbs and prepositions. It is important to say that some words are formed with two or three different affixes (prefixes and suffixes) in the same word, this process is known as multiple affixation, for instance *disaffection*.

**Class retaining Affixes.** Are the ones that when attached to the root word, don't produce a change in the part of speech. They modify the meaning of the base to which they are attached without changing its word class. For example we add the prefix *dis-* to the verb *abuse* and the result is another verb *disabuse*.

**Meaning of Affixes.** There are many prefixes in the English language but some of them are only used in nouns, adjectives or in verbs. Here is the list of the affixes used in this work that are attached to verbs.

## DERIVATION

It is the action of forming and obtaining new words from already existing resources of a language. With derivation we can change the meaning of a word without changing its grammatical category, nor eliminating the class which a certain word belongs<sup>iv</sup>. This work is focused on both types of changes. Derivation is an important way of obtaining new words by adding affixes to existing ones.

**Morpheme.** A morpheme is the smallest meaningful unit in the grammar language.<sup>v</sup> Morphemes are classified into: root, stem, and affix.

**Root.** It is any unit to which affixes of any kind can be added. Roots tend to have a core meaning which is, in any way, modified by the affix. For instance, the root *adopt* can form the adjective *adoptable*, the noun *adoption*, and so on. In this work, root words are the base form of the verbs.

### **INFLECTION**

It is a variation in the form of a word by adding affixes. Inflection does not change the class of the word, but produces a change in meaning.<sup>vi</sup> For example, cats. The s indicates number.

One difference that we can mention between inflection and derivation is that the first one never changes the category of the words, while derivation typically changes it. Both, Inflection and derivation usually produce a change in meaning. Derivation is not obligatory while inflection is. Inflection contributes with information such as number, gender, or aspect; derivation contributes with lexical meaning.

### **WORD CLASSES OR PARTS OF SPEECH**

Word classes are also known as parts of speech or lexical category. In English, there are about fifteen word classes. Among these categories we can mention nouns, adjectives, prepositions, adverbs and verbs.<sup>vii</sup> But this work is only focused on the derivative form of verbs that can be nouns, adjectives, and

adverbs.

**Adjective.** Adjectives are often called describing words because they provide information about the qualities of a noun, a noun phrase, or a clause. They modify the nouns they are written with, that is, they tell us qualities of a noun, such as its size, shape, condition, age, color, origin, etc.

There are some structural features that are unique to adjectives. One feature concerns suffixes that are typical of adjectives. That is, there are certain suffixes that are found only with adjectives such as -al, -ive, -ous, -ic, -less, -ish, -ful, -able, etc.<sup>viii</sup>

**Adverb.** It tells us something about the verbs with which they occur; that is, they modify those verbs. Adverbs can also modify adjectives, nouns and other adverbs in similar ways. The most common formal feature of the adverb is that the majority end with the suffix -ly, for example, slowly. However, this characteristic is not exclusive to adverbs.<sup>ix</sup>

**Noun.** A noun can be described as a person, place, animal or thing. According to Jeremy Harmer, a noun is "a word (or group of words) that is the name of a person, a place, a thing or activity or a quality or idea."<sup>x</sup> In fact, we use nouns to express "a range of additional meanings, such as: concepts, qualities, organizations, communities, sensations and events"<sup>xi</sup>. Nouns convey a substantial proportion of the information in most texts and they also denote abstract and concrete entities.<sup>xii</sup> For example: child, embarrassment, house, etc.

**Verbs.** People often think of verbs as doing words or action words. We use verbs to describe actions, experiences, existence, mental conditions and processes, relationships, or state of beings. In terms of meaning, their importance varies considerably. To Romans, verbs were the most important of all the parts of speech.<sup>xiii</sup> Verbs can be classified into many ways. In this work, it is important to mention one of the types that verbs belong to: *regular* and *irregular* verbs. But it is important to emphasize that we are only focusing on regular verbs.

**Regular verbs.** These are verbs which past tense form end with the –ed morpheme, as well as their participle form. They are called regular because they consistently have this ending form, their forms are rule governed. For example work- worked and had worked.

Another division of verbs that we use in this paper is the distinction between transitive and intransitive verbs. But we are going to use only the transitive ones.

**Transitive verbs.** These are verbs that must have objects after them, so they can transfer their actions onto a noun phrase. Only a transitive verb can be followed by a direct object. They are also called “object verbs”.<sup>xiv</sup> Dictionaries identify transitive verbs with the abbreviation *v.t.* for “verb transitive”.<sup>xv</sup>

### **SECTION III**

### **CONCLUSION**

This project has been the best one I have ever done in my life. Its elaboration has left me with a lot of new knowledge. I have learned things I did not know when I began to do this glossary. I learned to use the web in a better and more efficient way. I found new books I did not previously know. I also developed essential skills that have helped me to more efficiently use dictionaries as tools of investigation.

At the beginning I thought this was going to be an easy project, but while doing it, I realized that even "easy" things require time, dedication, devotion, and patience. To do this work, it took me more time than I had expected, but the results are worth it.

The information obtained and presented here, that is, the theoretical framework, the verbs and the list of affixes, was the result of hours of reading and research into many different books, websites, and dictionaries.

From the many verbs I initially planned to use, I had to reduce the list to the most common regular and transitive ones, because I had to find a way to limit this project. With the list of affixes, I only used the ones that I got from derivative words. Some affixes were not used, such as the ones that are added to a root word, that is, an adjective or a verb.

Some words, with the affix attached, changed their meaning completely. That indicated that they belonged to another root word. Such is the case of *join* when it was attached the suffix –er, it became *joiner*; which in British English has the Spanish meaning of “carpintero”. This word does not have anything to do with the Spanish term verb “unir”. Such words were not added to this work.

I found out that the most used prefixes were *dis*, *re*, and *un*. I could see that in most of the cases, these prefixes did not change the grammatical category of the word to which they were attached. Such is the case of *dis* when attached to the verb *engage* it remains as a verb.

The most common suffixes were *ble*, *ment*, *tion* and *sion*. In almost every verb, there is a derivative word which contains one of these suffixes to denote adjectives and nouns. For example, the verb *advise* becomes *advisable* which is an adjective. The verb *tempt* becomes *temptation* which is a noun.

Some affixes are only attached to adjectives or nouns, but in the case of multiple affixation, when we have a derivative word that can be a noun or an adjective, we can only use the affixes for adjectives or nouns because we already have those words formed. This can be exemplified in the case of *offend*; when attached to the suffix *ive*, it becomes *offensive* which is an adjective, but if we add the suffix *ness* (only used in adjectives) to the derived word it becomes the abstract noun *offensiveness*. Like this case, we could find many others in this work.

Some words have two functions, but the same meaning in the Spanish language. Such words were written in the same line but divided by a dash (/). Such is the case of *collectivist* which has the function of an adjective and noun, and in the Spanish language it means the same.

Other words have the same derivative word, two functions, and two meanings in Spanish. *Captive* as adjective is *cautivado*, but as a noun is *cautivo*. These words were also divided by a dash.

Some nouns and adjectives can apply to a male or a female. In these cases, both are written. For example, *baker* can be a man or a woman. Also, some definitions in the Spanish language are of little usage in the present; so, modern words were used to replace the old ones.

Many verbs in the *ing* and in the *ed* form function as adjectives without changing their forms. These forms are called *ing* and *ed adjectives<sup>xvi</sup>*, such as *opened* and *opening*. These derivative words were not added to this work because they are inflectional changes.

Some other words in English did not appear in the Spanish dictionary, which means they do not exist in the Spanish language or are seldom used. Such words were not added to this work even though they were derivatives. This was because the aim of this work is to provide vocabulary and not to confuse students with words they rarely use in English.
